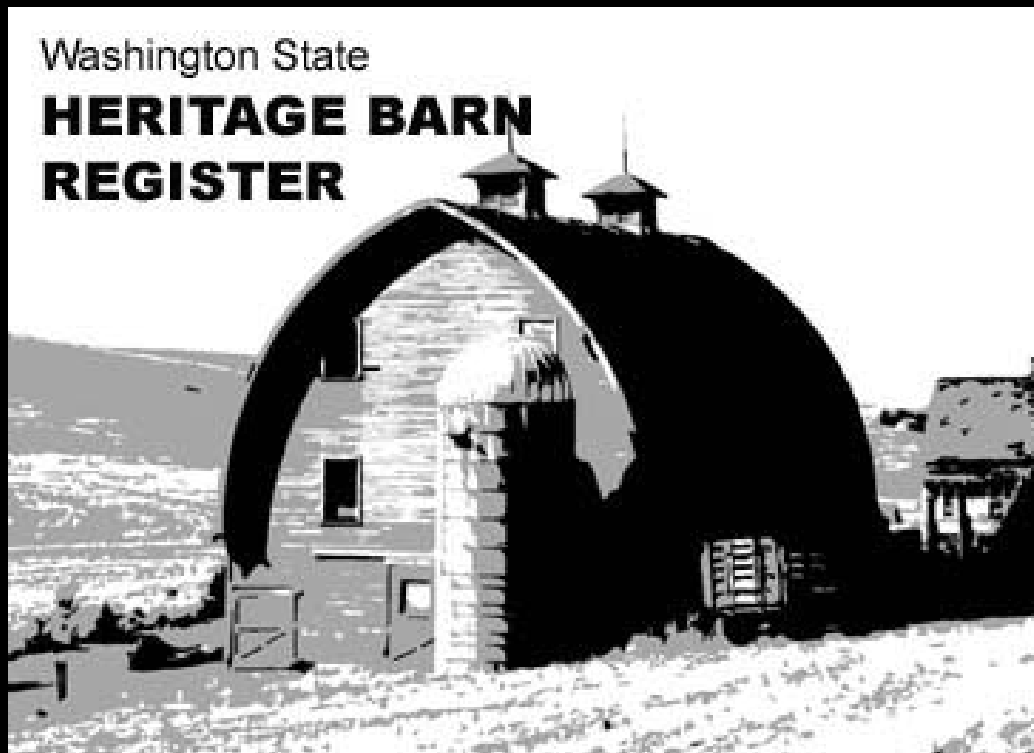

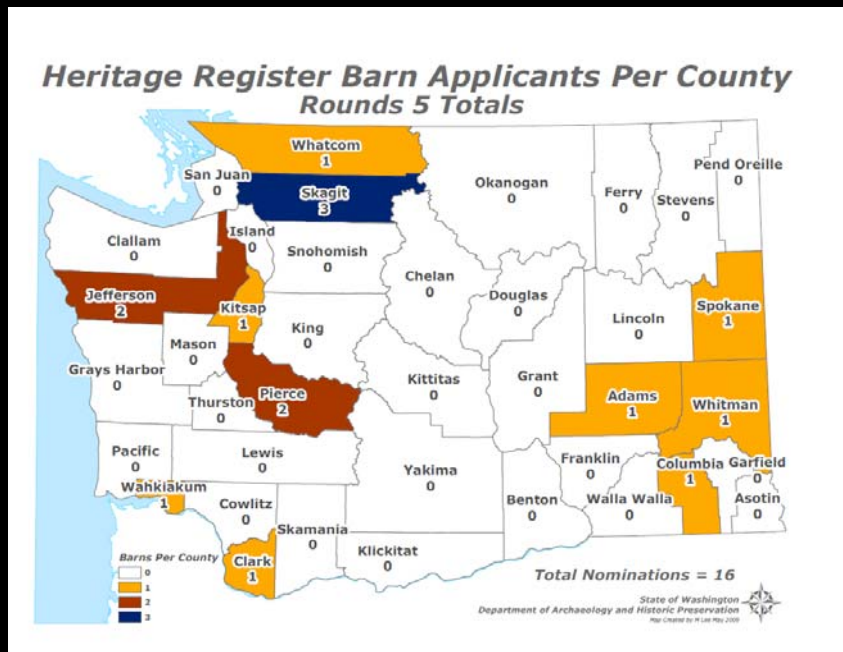

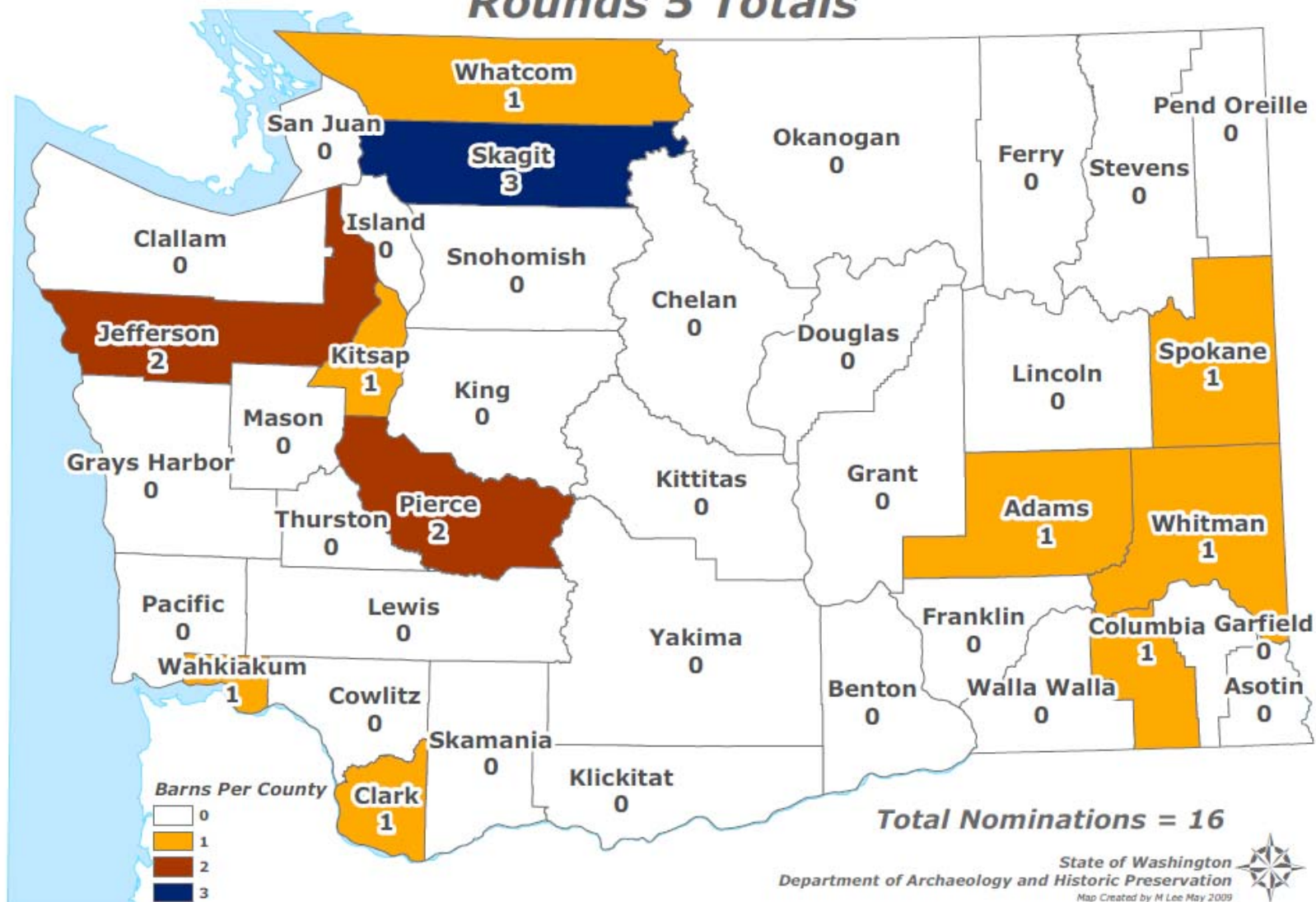


The Nominations for listing on the Washington Heritage Barn Register by County



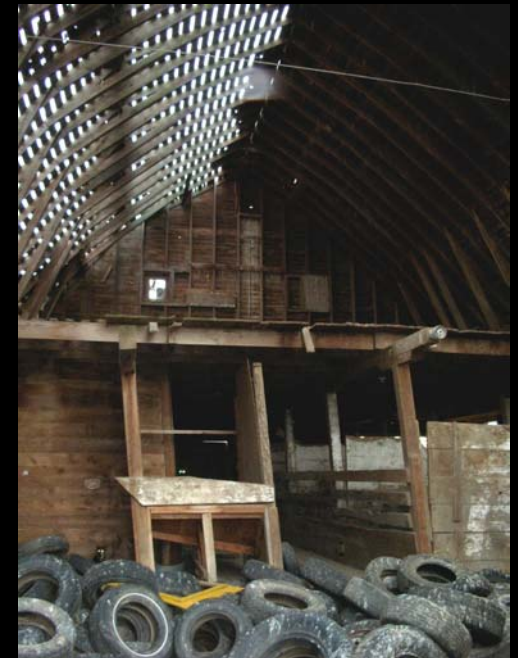

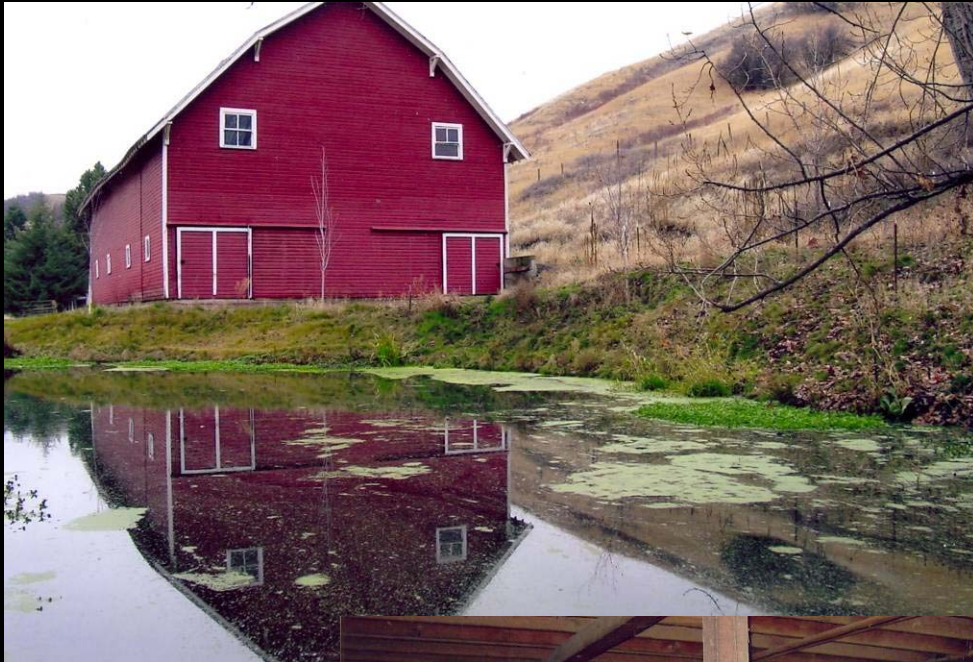

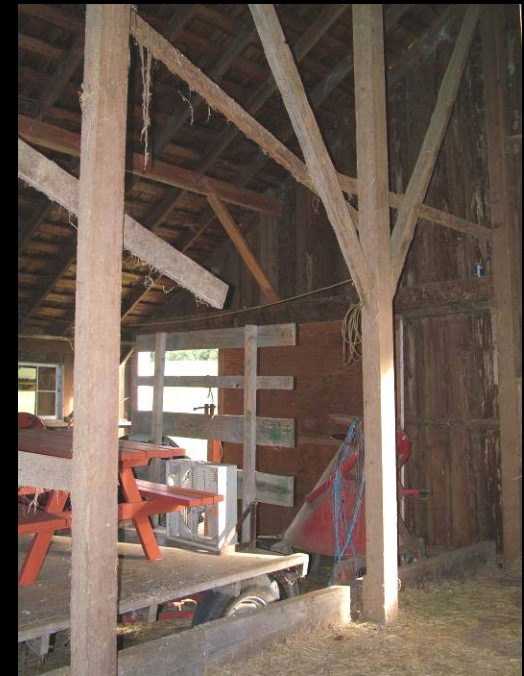
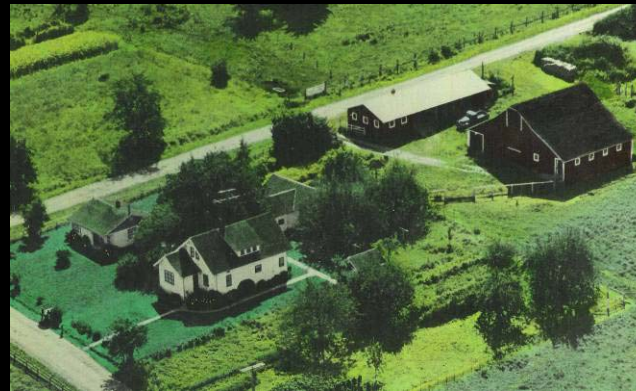

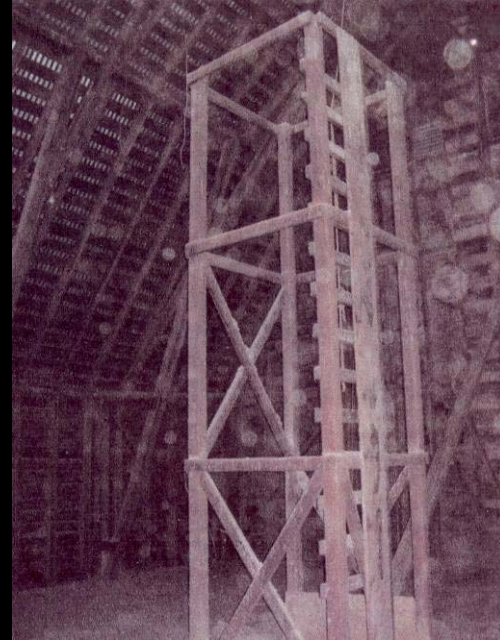
