Compact Living in Marine View Homes

Today's one-level house might well be called a house divided.

It's really half-in-half in that active areas are arranged on one side and sleeping and bathing areas on the other side. Such is good planning for the informal way we live today.

Douglas Viary is the designer of this one-level house of 1,380 square feet; James D. Burns is the builder. Open-house hours are from noon to 7 p. m. at 2121 1/2 S. Marine View Homes Addition.

The plan wastes no space. The entry is indicated by a square of slate and a wood grille and from this central site all rooms may be reached with ease.

Plenty of Light
Living and dining areas are planned together—each having a large window to light the spot gray-green walls. The fireplace is sandstone.

From the dining area a door opens into the kitchen, conveniently planned with an island in U-shaped plan. The sink is below the window, with space reserved for a dishwasher, budget permitting. Counters are a light-green tile with a deep-green splash-back. The refrigerator stands in one corner of the inside wall with space beside it for a serving cart or a breakfast table for two. Walls are cream; cabinets are birch.

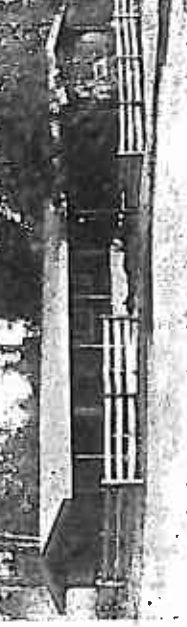
Large Garage
An island counter, with open shelves above, separates the kitchen and family room. Here garden for indoor-outdoor play is a room, 13 by 18 feet, large. At the end of the room a stone trough accommodates the dog and a hot bath are handy activities of the growing brood for the children. Colors range from the one wall to the other, to the window, to the water heater, are placed compactly on the inside wall.

The plan contains three bedrooms. The master bedroom is large with individual wardrobe. Walls are warm-toned pink; the ceiling is off-white to reflect the natural light from the window wall.

One smaller bedroom is decorated in peach tones—the other in gold. The family bath is tiled smartly in black and white—white-tile floor and dressing counter and a black trim. The upper walls are painted pale pink.

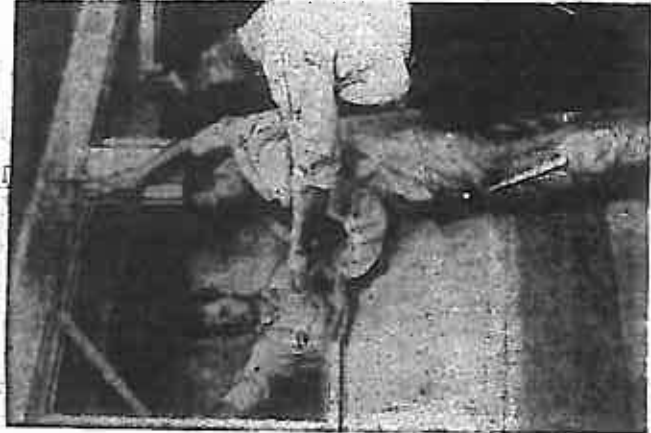
