## Construction Work Shows Dip in July

July contracts for construction in 11 Western states totaled \$600,164,000, a drop of 17 per cent from the same month last year, the F. W. Dodge Corp. construction news firm, reported yesterday.

The decrease resulted from a sharp drop in heavy engineering, particularly in water supply and electric installations. The heavy engineering category, totaling \$165,818,000, was down 34 per cent.

Non-residential construction totaling \$124,350,000 was up 5 per cent. Residential construction of \$474,814,000 was down 9 per cent.

However, cumulative contracts in all categories for the first seven months of this year were up 6 per cent over the same period last year, with a \$1,658,876,000 total.

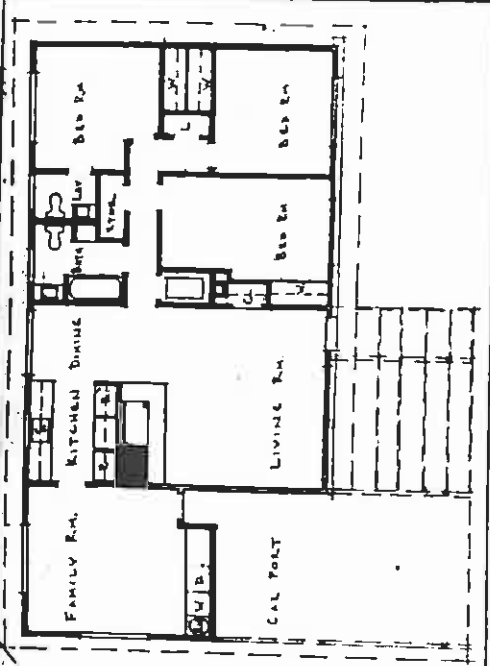
