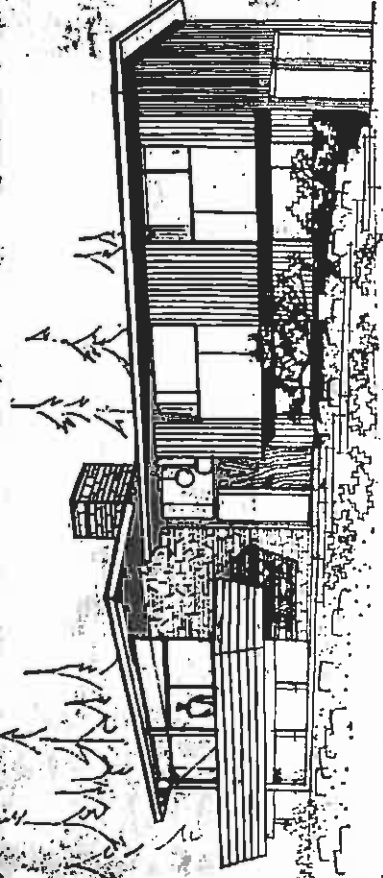
HOW TO GET TO OCEAN SHORES

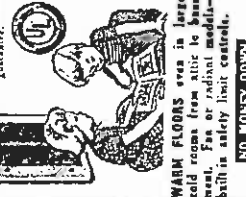

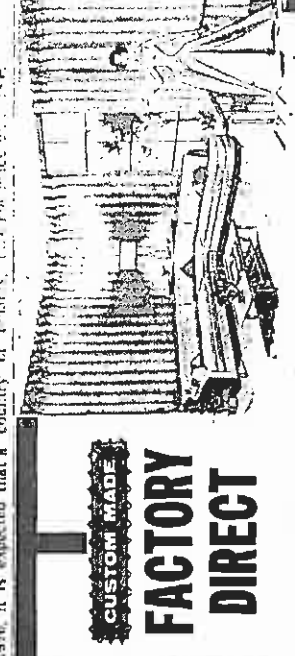

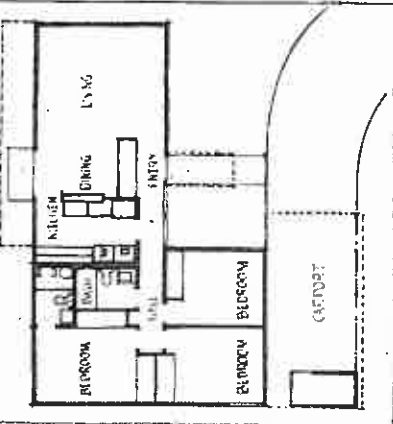

Charles C. Ralls, state director of civil defense, says that adequate shielding, that is sufficiently thick concrete, wood or dirt, is the only effective method of protecting persons from radiation in event of atomic attack.

The shelters in today's houses are designed so they may serve as playrooms for children or for other family uses.

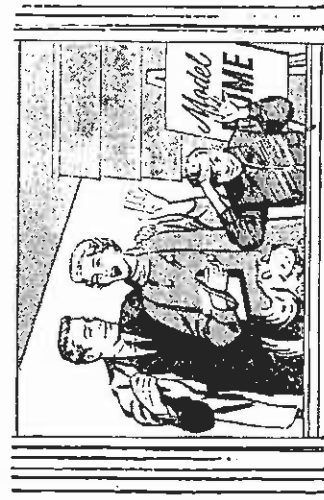

Farmers Use Ox Power in Logging

JACKSON, Ohio, Sept. 10 (UPI)—Even in this age of tractors, two-ox teams are still used to pull log skidders in some areas. The increasing number of oxen, two-ox teams, and oxen pulling log skidders, instead of tractors, is a trend that has been noted in several areas of the country. The use of oxen is particularly common in the West, where the rugged terrain and the need for heavy pulling power make them ideal. In some areas, oxen are used to pull heavy machinery up steep hillsides. The use of oxen is also popular in logging because they are less likely to get stuck in mud than tractors. Question: Why are homes so expensive in Seattle?

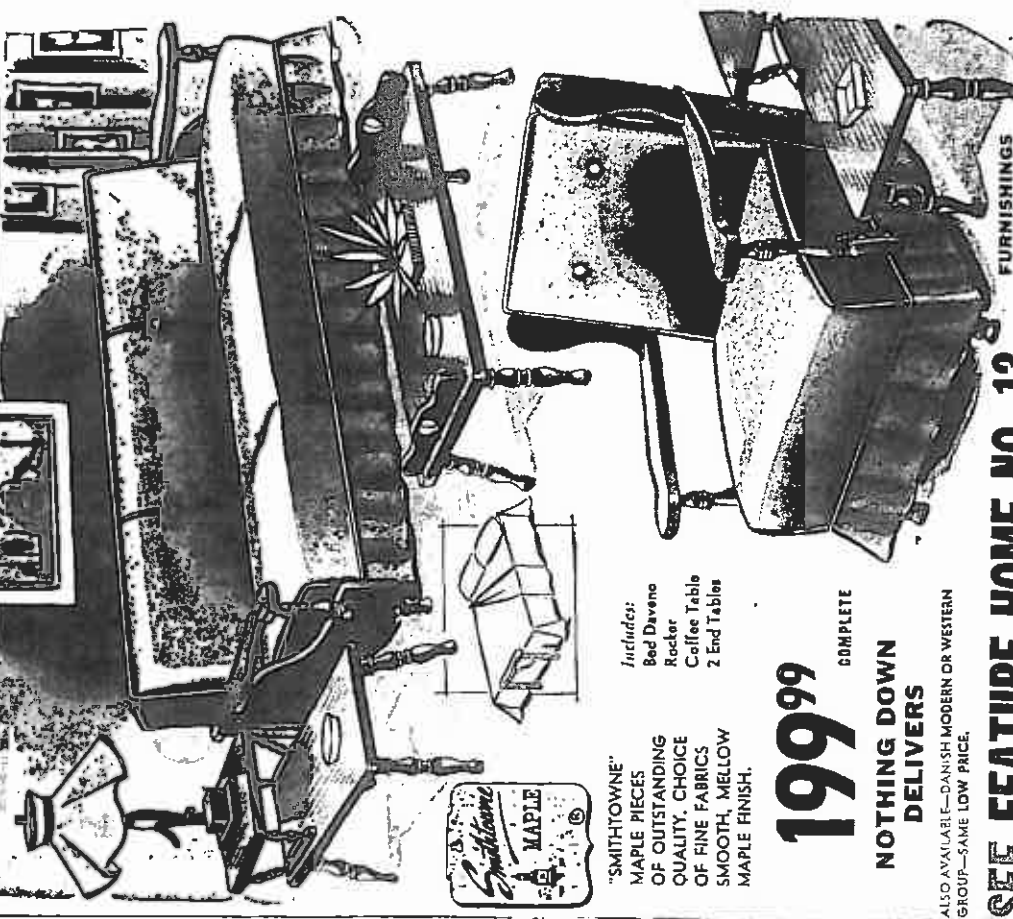
Answer: As you know, more and more people are demanding and buying better homes today than ever before. The average person buys a house that costs him two and a half to three times his annual income. More than 65 per cent of all families in the Greater Seattle area own their own homes, which is about as high a ratio as any place in the world. If homes were excessively expensive in this area, we would not enjoy this favorable ratio.—Richard W. Lennington, realtor.

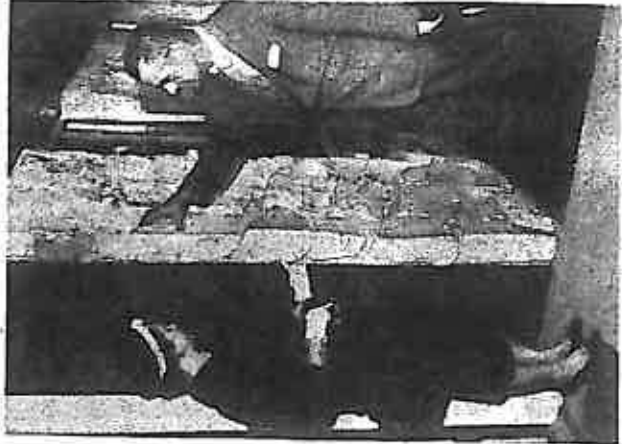

Need for More Workers In Construction Field Seen

WASHINGTON — Some 2,300,000 additional skilled workers in the construction field will be needed by 1970. "The estimated growth in Marvin Myers, chairman of construction," Myers said, "reflects upward trends in the labor committee of the National Association of Home Builders, says. Myers, a Rockford, Ill., high level of government home-builder, said the increase in expenditures for highways and other public works."
