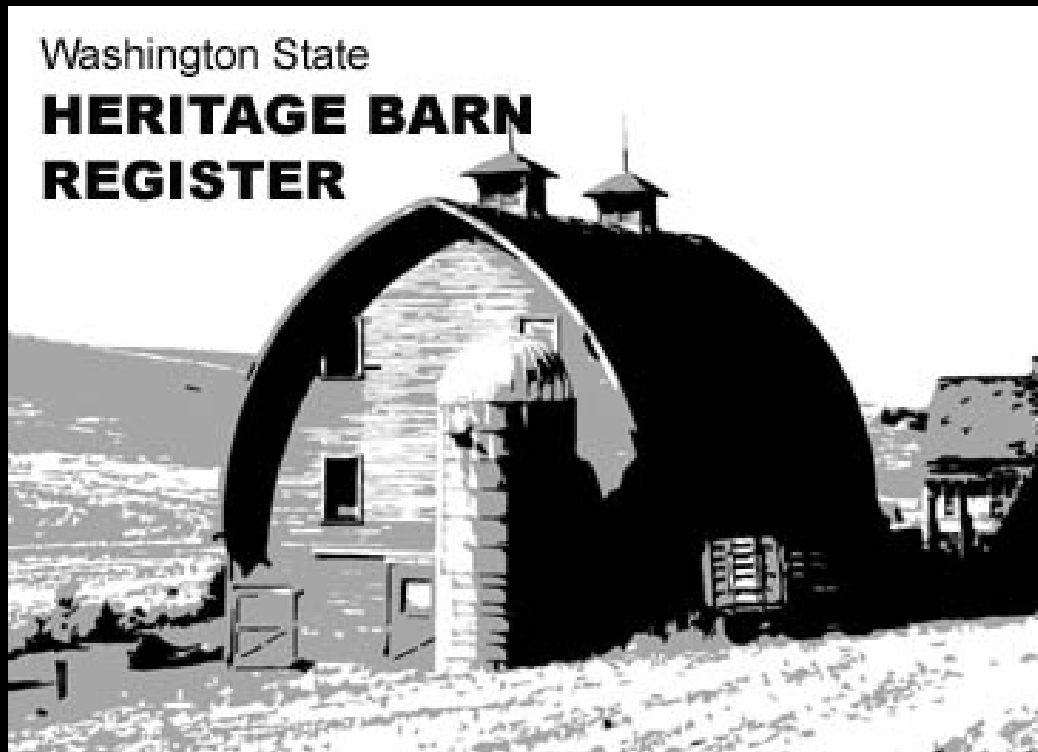

# Definition of Heritage Barn

Section (5) "Heritage Barn" means any large agricultural outbuilding used to house animals, crops, or farm equipment, that is over fifty years old and has been determined by the department to:

(a) Be eligible for listing on the Washington Heritage Register or the National Register of Historic Places; or (b) have been listed on a local historic register and approved by the advisory council.

In addition to barns, "heritage barn" includes agricultural resources such as milk houses, sheds, silos, or other outbuildings, that are historically associated with the working life of the farm or ranch, if these outbuildings are on the same property as a heritage barn.

**PROPERTY HISTORY:** (Depend on the history of the barn/property such as use, builder, worked, family stories and memories, etc., add additional pages if necessary)  
 The barn was built around 1913 by a man named Beal. The oldest living past resident of the property, Mike Wilson, reported that it was originally used for rabbits, the farrowing sows as bedding material. The barn was later used as a dairy barn and for raising beef. Mike Wilson is a local legend and still alive in his nineties, he remembers milking cows in the barn. He has many fond memories of stacking hay in the barn and of the winter basketball games that took place in the loft with local kids, many of whom still live here in the area. He currently farms the property and sell certified organic produce through a CSA program and at local farmers markets. He has a lot of interaction with the public and host an annual open house as well as periodic farm tours. He would love to showcase the barn when there were with the public to see place. The barn has profiled siding, exposed knee trading, extensive trim detail and decorative siding at gable ends.

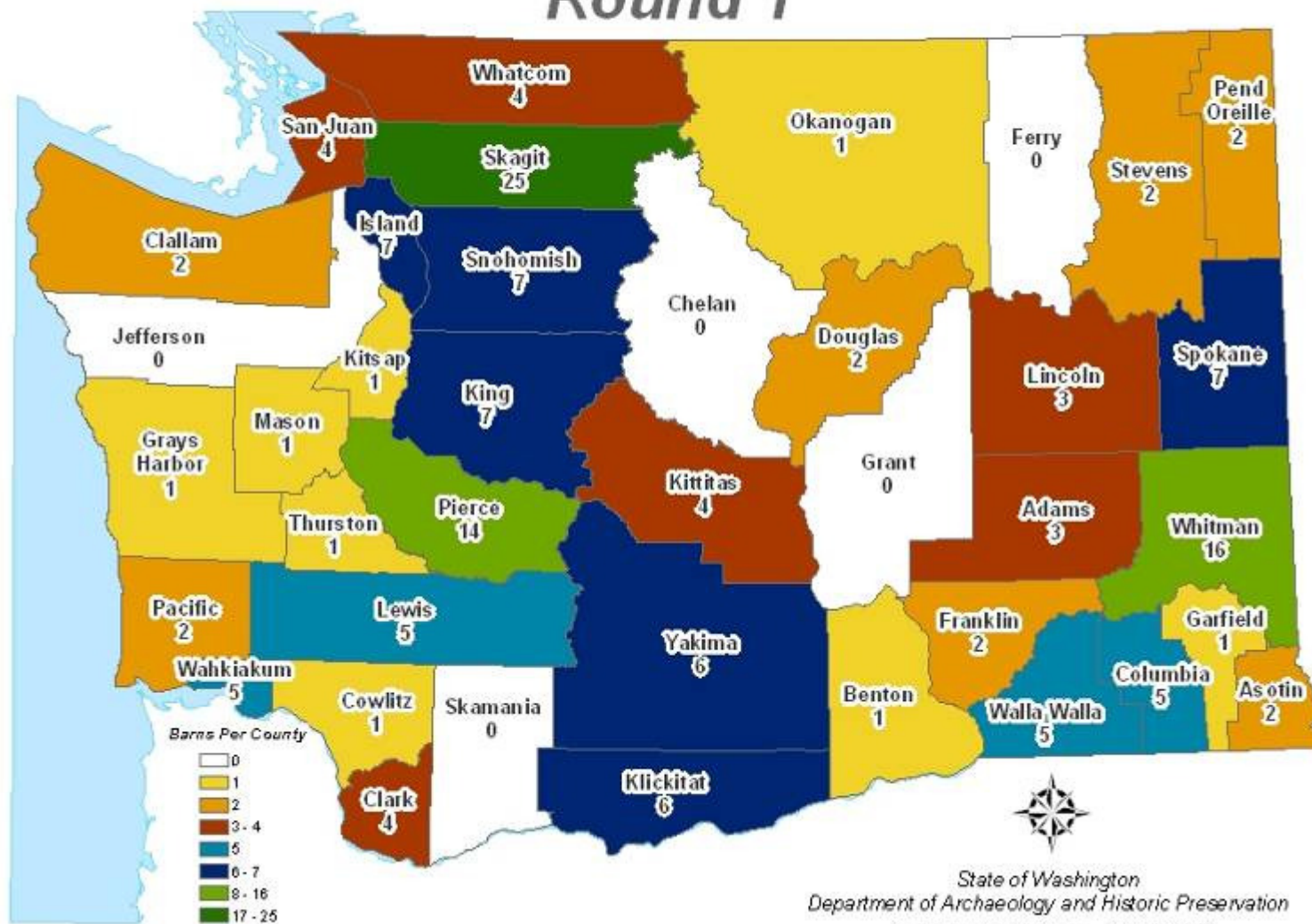

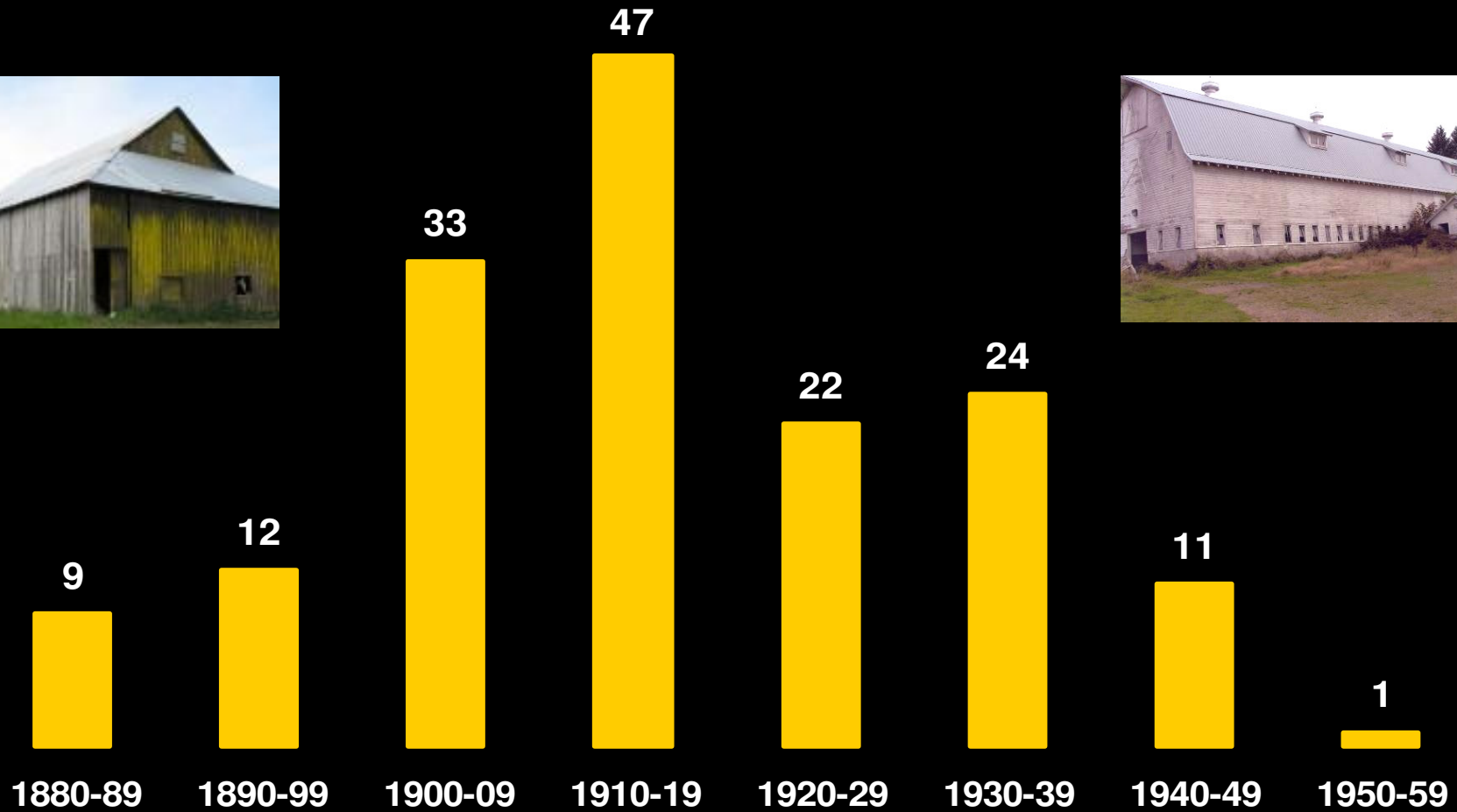
