


Michael S. Donohue

M. S. DONOHUE.

A few moments' walk from East Sound towards North Beach and we come to the home of Mr. M. S. Donohue, who is numbered among the foremost and progressive residents of Orcas Island. Here is a most desirable ranch of 130 acres of which over 50 acres are under the plow. The land is delightfully situated, well drained and has most excellent water. It is principally devoted to raising hay, grains and peas, and for dairying purposes. Mr. Donohue



M. S. DONOHUE'S HOME

was born in Ireland in 1841. Five years later, with his parents, he came to Washington county, New York, where he was reared on the farm. In 1862 he enlisted in the Union Army in Company K, 123d N. W. V. I., and served until the close of the Civil war. He marched with Sherman to the sea. At the close of the war he returned to New York and in 1866 went west to Missouri, where he engaged in the carpenter trade, more especially in railroad work. For a while he was on the H. & St. J. R. R., then on the Ft. Scott & Gulf Railroad as bridge carpenter, and later on the M., K. & T. R. R. He came to Washington in 1882 and located on Orcas Island in 1883. His estimable wife was Miss M. A. Lynn, of Illinois, whom he married in 1870. We give a view of the Donohue home.











Gasworks Park 'Opening Day'




THE FIRST portion of Seattle's Lake Union Park, being built on the site of an abandoned gas plant, was opened to the waiting public yesterday, and P-I Reporter Susan Chadwick easily found a vantage point for her observations. It was only an observation point that opened yesterday. The rest of the 20-acre site will be cleared of oil-soaked soil by year's end, and during the following year workmen will remove some of the old gas plant equipment, leaving the rest to stand as stark sculpture in a field of green on the north shores of Lake Union. 






